

# BOWERHILL SCHOOL, MELKSHAM, WILTSHIRE NEW CLASSROOM BLOCK AND INTERNAL REFURBISHMENT

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Six classroom extension to an existing 1980's school. The design intension was to provide an extension that was sympathetic to the existing. The existing school had a central corridor top lit and this was interpreted in the new design by creating top lit circulation with cloakroom areas between classrooms.

The ground was a heavy clay which involved additional protection in the form of expansion boards.

There was also additional work within the school involving the enlargement of the existing school hall, creating a new staffroom and toilets and a mezzanine floor in part of the central corridor.
