The brief was to demolish the 1960s extension to a Victorian school in the Conservation Area in the West Wiltshire village of Barford St Martin and to construct a new Classroom and Toilets replacing those lost in the demolition. We then converted an existing Storeroom into a Kitchen; and the existing large Classroom into a Hall for use by the School and local community.

The site was very tight so to achieve the required space the Classroom was designed to run parallel to the boundary.
